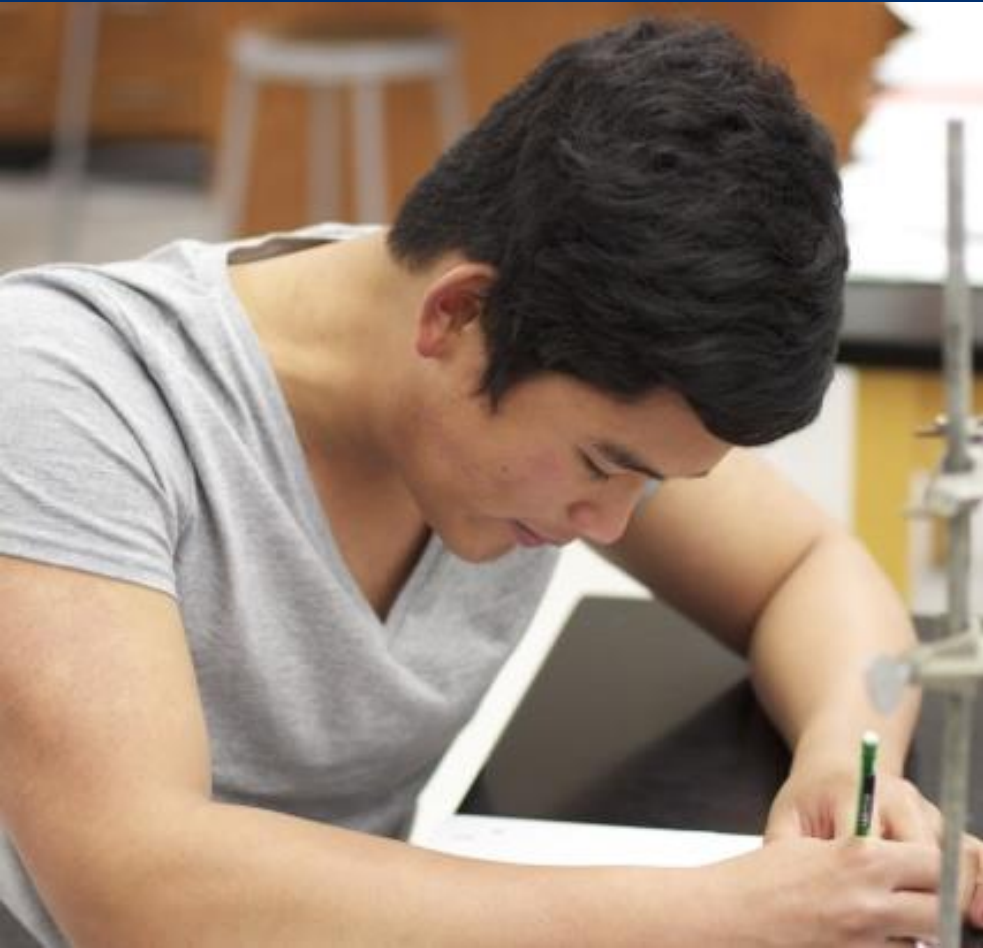

# K12 SWP Dashboard: Making Sense of the Data

The dashboard includes data for an institution or LEA if they received K12 SWP funding

...but there are limitations

- All necessary CALPADS data files must be successfully uploaded to Cal-PASS Plus
  - Missing files or missing years of data impact what can be displayed
  - With every release displayed data may change due to more data being submitted
- Data are at the student level, but it is aggregated and presented at the institution or LEA level
  - Data represent students at funded institutions but is not representative of a particular funding source (i.e., CETIG) or any direct program services

# Dashboards in the LaunchBoard

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**K12 SWP**—displays data for students enrolled in grades 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade at a Cal-PASS Plus participant K12 institution awarded K12 SWP funding

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**Strong Workforce Program**—displays data for CTE students on all CTE programs, industry sectors and individual programs (using the four- and six-digit Taxonomy of Program coding).

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**Community College Pipeline**—is the most comprehensive dashboard with nearly 150 metrics, offering views of students at the industry sector and program level.

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**Adult Education Pipeline**—displays data for K-12 adult education and community college noncredit student journeys, including progress, transition, completion and workforce outcomes.

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**Student Success Metrics**—showcases student progression along various educational journeys, from recruitment to completion, transfer and the workforce for a Cohort and Snapshot view

# Where does the data come from that populates the LaunchBoard Dashboards?

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K12 information from CALPADS for K12 SWP submitted to CalPASS Plus

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K12 adult ed information from CASAS for Adult Education Pipeline

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Student and program term and annual files (submitted by college institutional research offices to the Chancellor's Office MIS)

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Employment and earnings data from Employment Development Department

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Employment outcomes from the CTE Outcomes Survey administered by Santa Rosa Junior College

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Labor market information and online job postings data from Lightcast (formerly Emsi) in Community College Pipeline

# Resources to help with understanding the data displayed

- Notes on graphs provide information about the metric displayed
- Pop-up text includes more information if needed
- Metric Definition Dictionary (MDD) provides metric descriptions, data sources, data elements, data values, and calculations and overall information about the dashboard

- Added data for [SY 2020-21 and SY 2021-22 for Rounds 1 and 2 awardees, and SY 2021-22 for Round 3 awardees](#)



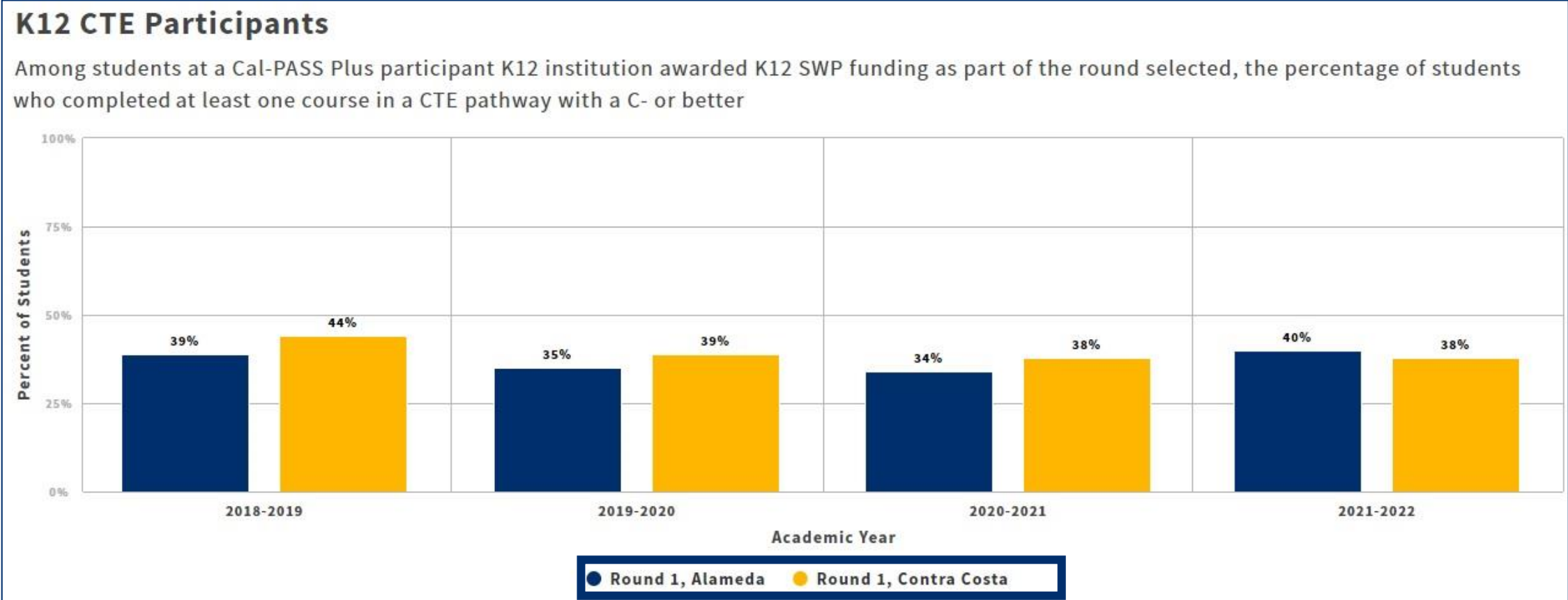

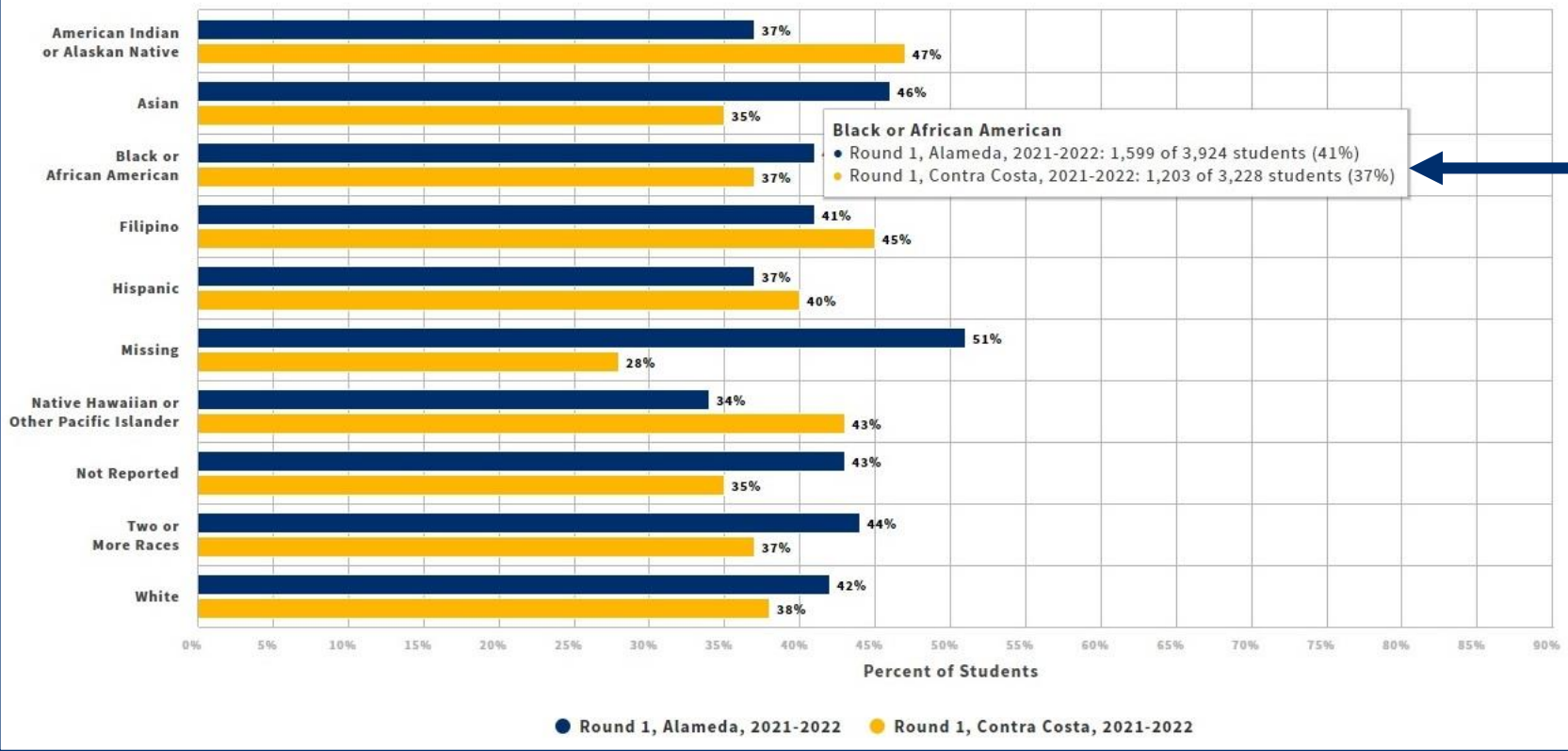

# Educational Dashboard Data: How can it be Useful

- Takes time to collect and merge data from an entire system
- May not want to display outcome data collected right away

# Nuts and Bolts of the K12 SWP Dashboard Data

What data is included in the K12 SWP dashboard :

- Aggregated student level data for 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders
- for LEAs awarded K12 SWP funding in Rounds 1, 2, or 3
- who have successfully uploaded their CALPADS files to Cal-Pass Plus
- with data displayed for institutions mapped to the funded LEAs
- with data also displayed at the LEA, county, region, statewide levels

# Nuts and Bolts of the K12 SWP Dashboard Data

- Provides aggregated student counts for those funded LEAs
- Allows us to understand what percentage of those students are CTE students, participants, completers, completers with early college credit, completers by industry sector, and HS graduates
- Aggregates the student level data to see outcomes at the institution, LEA, county, region or statewide level
- Does NOT allow us to understand which exact students were directly impacted by the investments made with the K12 SWP dollars distributed since data submitted should include all students
- Does NOT allow us to understand the impact of K12 SWP expenditures vs CTEIG or other programmatic expenditures

# Nuts and Bolts of the K12 SWP Dashboard Data

However, without the Cal-PASS Plus data there is NO story to tell with quantitative aggregated student level data about the K12 SWP program at any level (LEA or statewide)

*We* want to be able to tell the story of the impact of the K12 SWP funds and the good work that you are doing

*You* can tell your story with dashboard data for those of you who are actively involved with using the K12 SWP funding

- With your knowledge of which courses, students, CTE pathways, or industry sectors were funded

# More LEAs Reported Between Releases for Round 1 Awardees

More *K12 SWP students* reported in 2018-19 and 2019-20 Round 1 Awardees with additional awardees successfully reporting data in this release

More students included for Round 1:

- Statewide by 23% in 2019 and 31% in 2020
- In All regions
- In 72% of counties included in the dashboard

# Less Data Reported in Later Years for Round 1 Awardees Included in the First Release

The number of *K12SWP students* reported decreased for awardees of Round 1 funding in 2021 and in 2022 compared to prior years

Less students included for Round 1 in 2021 and 2022 compared to 2019:

- Statewide less students by 14% in 2021 and 36% in 2022 compared to 2019
- In 11 out of 15 regions in 2022
- In 66% of counties included in the dashboard in 2022

# What data years of data should be included?

- Round 1 awardees, need all necessary CALPADS files for four years, 2018-19 through 2021-22, to Cal-PASS Plus
- Round 2 awardees, need all necessary CALPADS files for two years, 2020-21 through 2021-22, to Cal-PASS Plus
- **If you don't see your data on the dashboard, but you believe that it has been uploaded:**
  1. EITHER the files were submitted after 01/18/23 in which case the data would not be included in this release of the dashboard
  2. OR the files were not successfully received
    - Even though you may have received an email from Cal-Pass Plus Help Desk

# Same Data Caveats in This Release

Number of CTE Completers reported can be greater than the number of CTE Students or CTE Participants since the information is in different CALPADS files

- In the selected year, a student may be flagged as a CTE Completer in the SCTE file but did not take a CTE course in the CRSC or SCSC file used to determine a CTE Student

# Same Data Caveats in This Release

- Gender, Race/Ethnicity: If a student's record is not in the SINF file in 2018-19 or later, then the student is assigned to a "Missing" gender or race/ethnicity subgroup
- English Learners: Due to not having access to the SELA file prior to 2018-19 to determine if a student has ever been flagged as an English Learner and never been reclassified, the number of students included as English Learners may be underrepresented compared to other CDE sources.
- Socioeconomically Disadvantaged, Homeless and Students with Disabilities: Due to not having access to the SPRG file prior to 2018-19 to determine if a student has ever been considered homeless, etc., the number of students included as homeless, etc. may be underrepresented compared to other CDE sources.

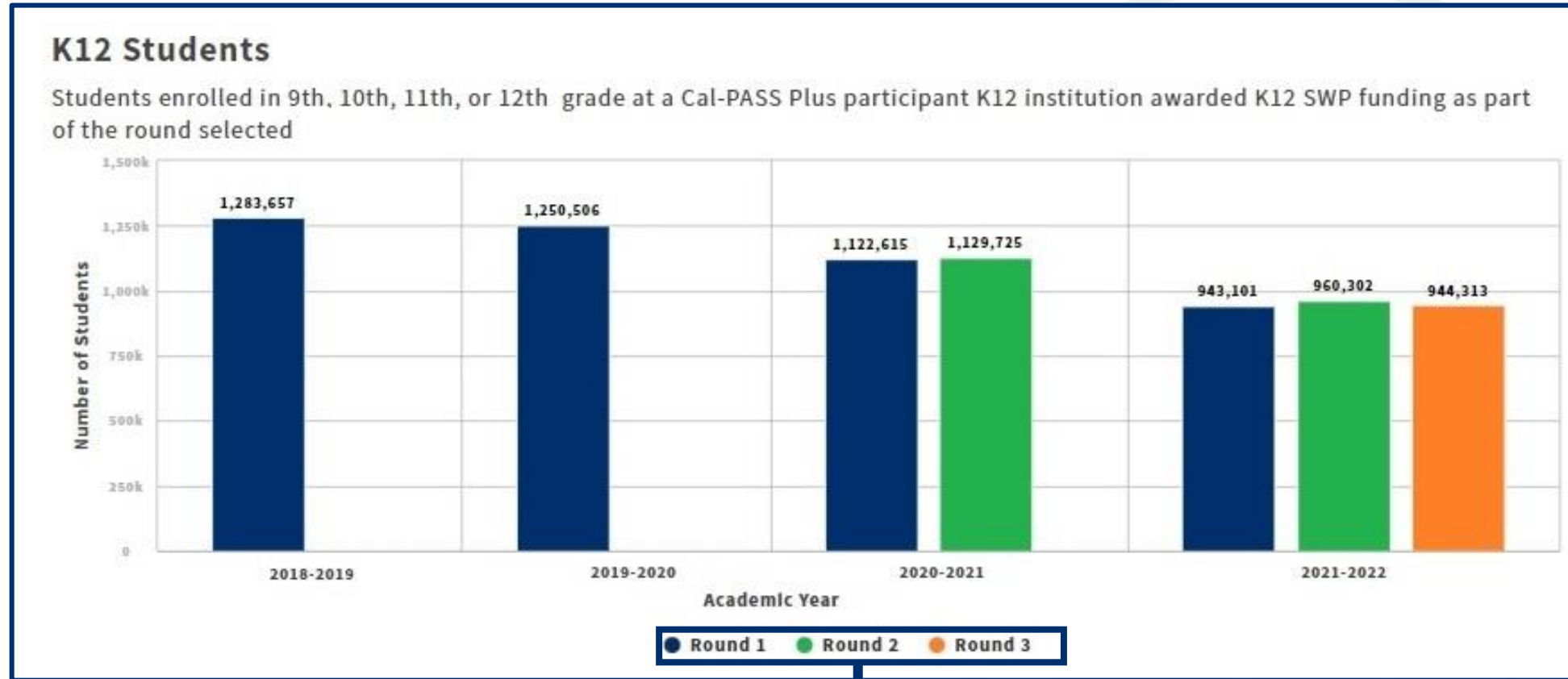

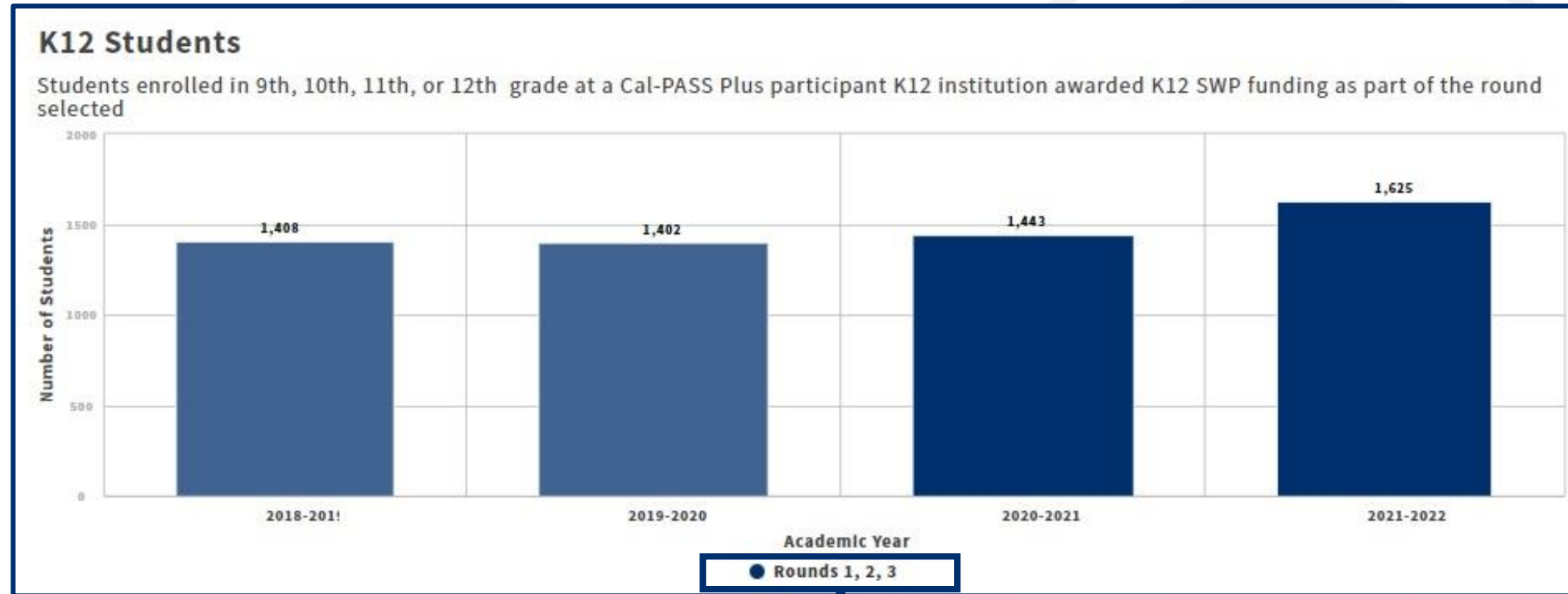

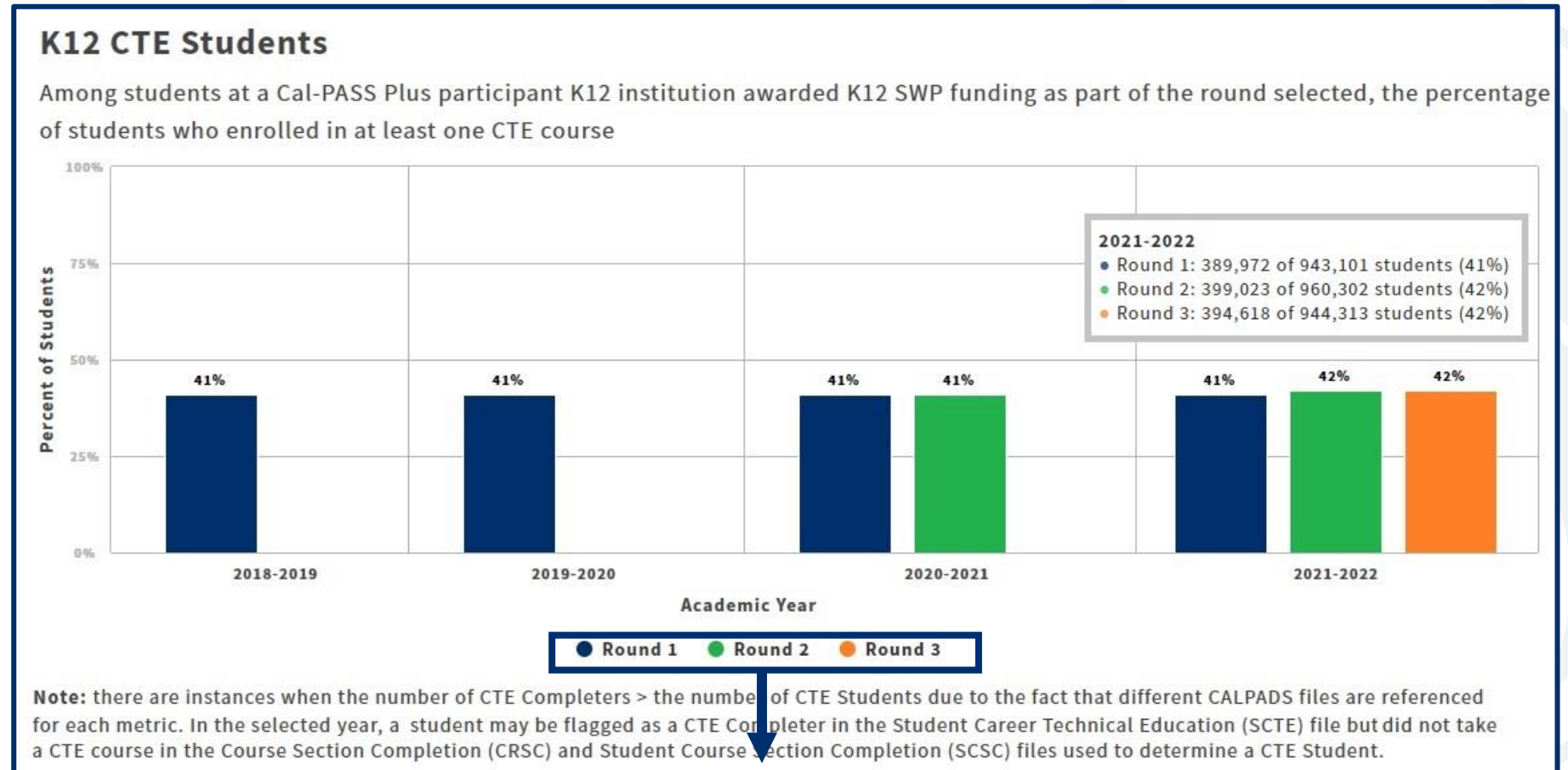

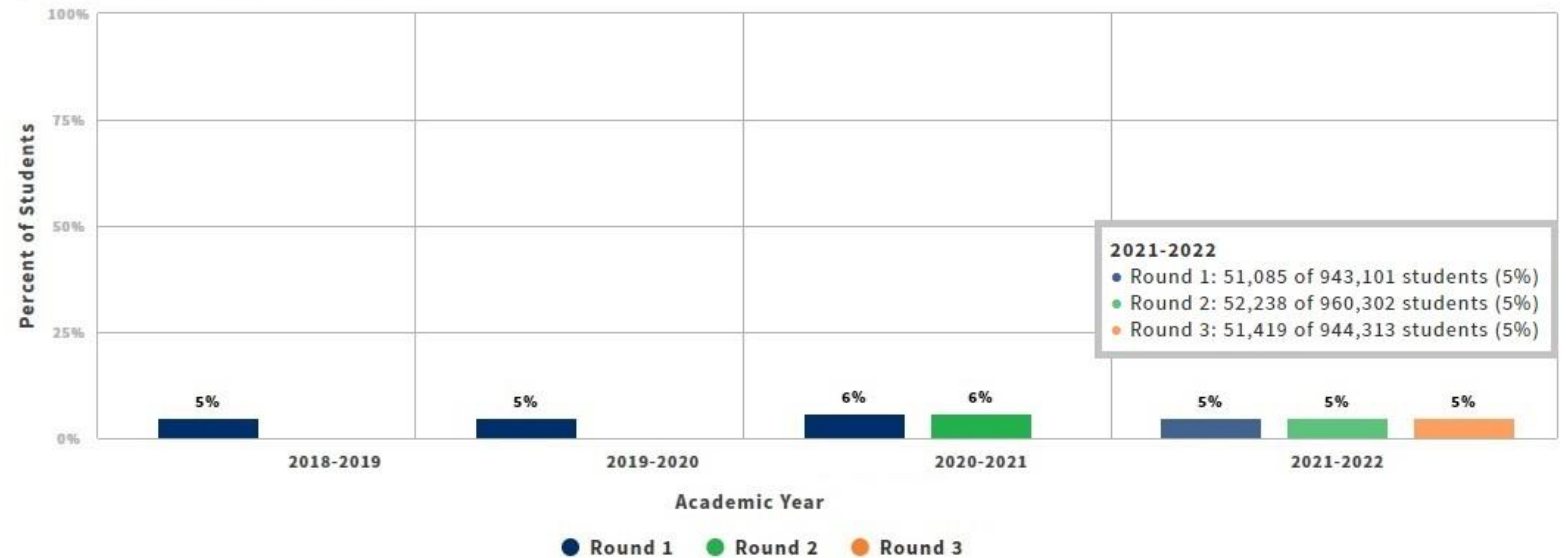

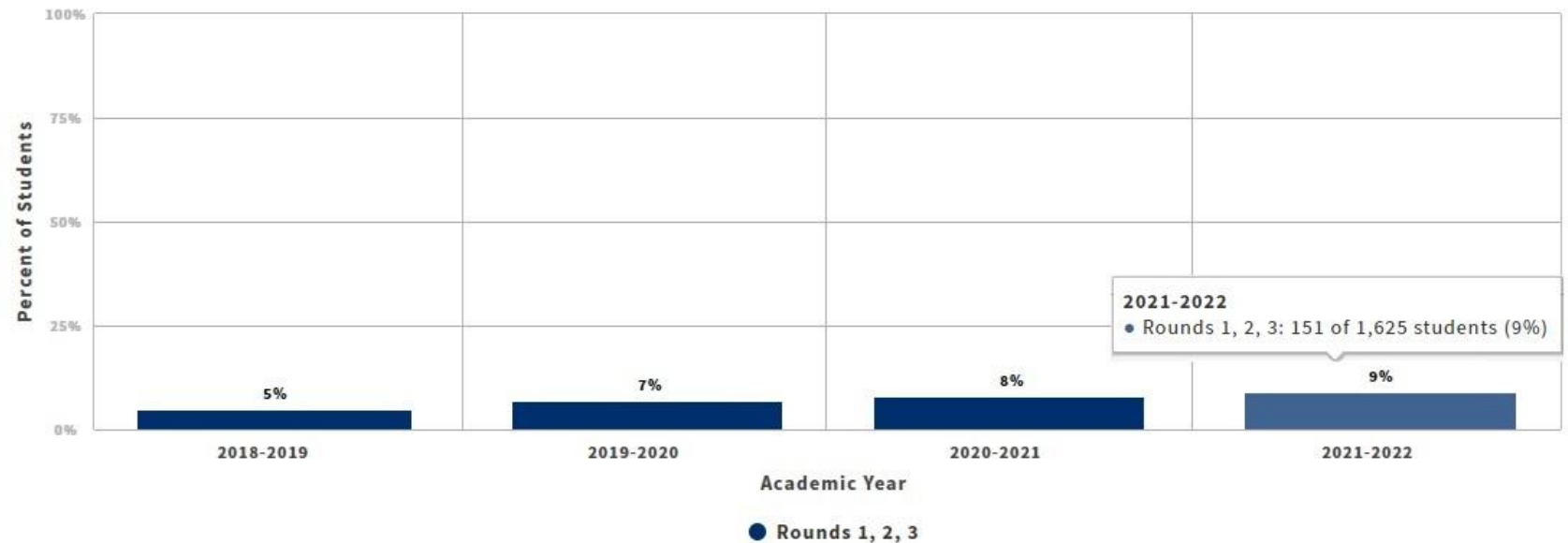

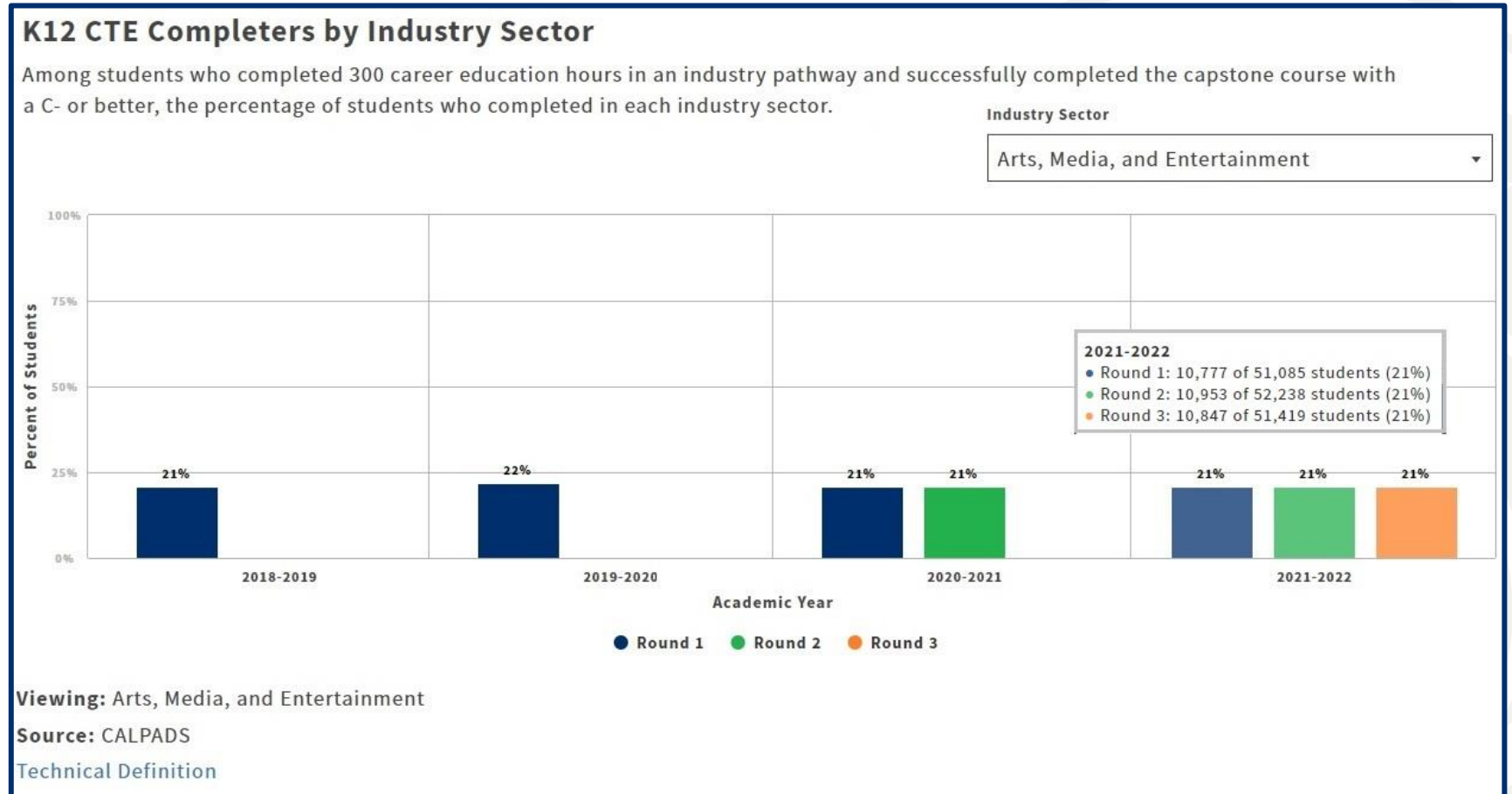

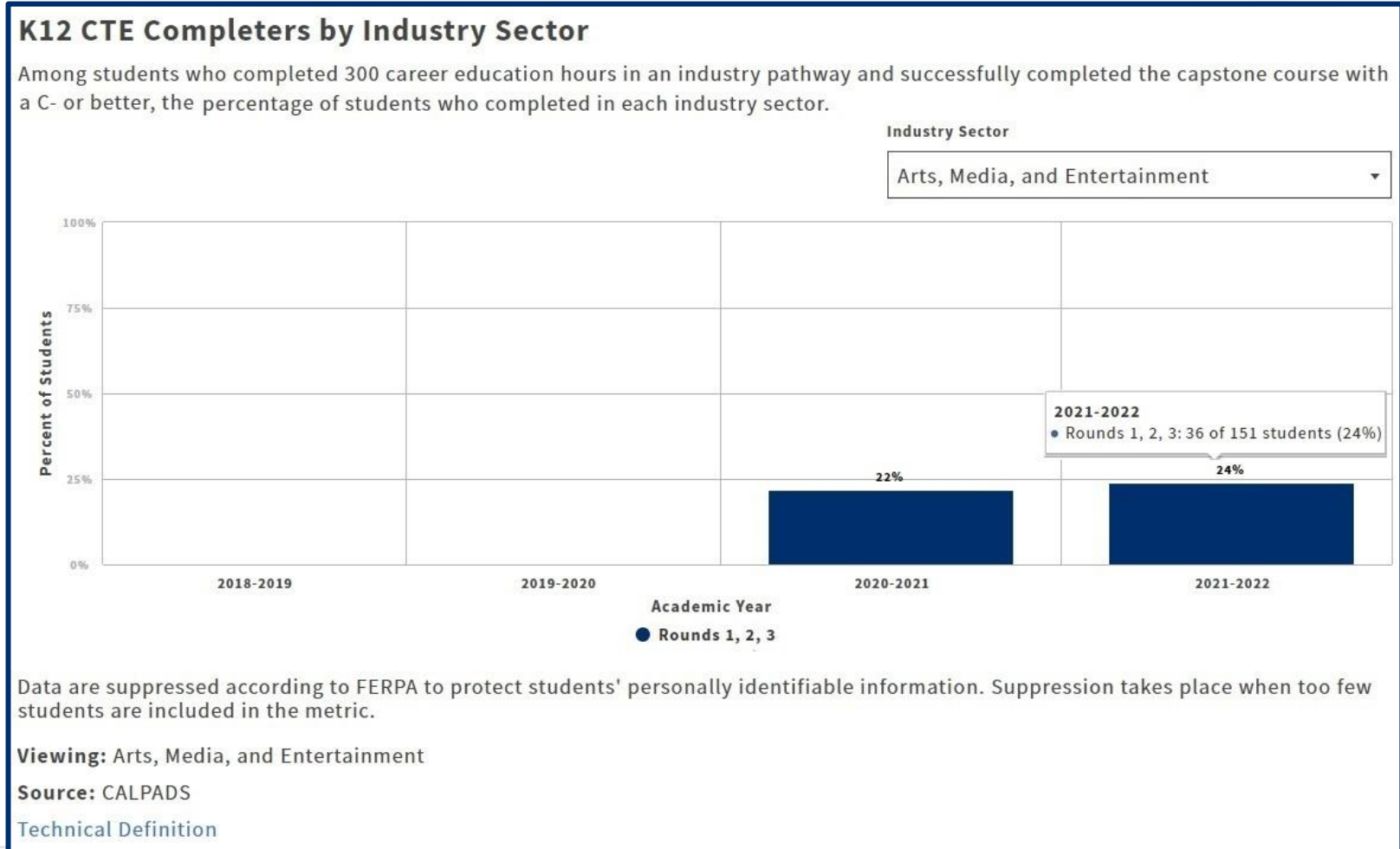

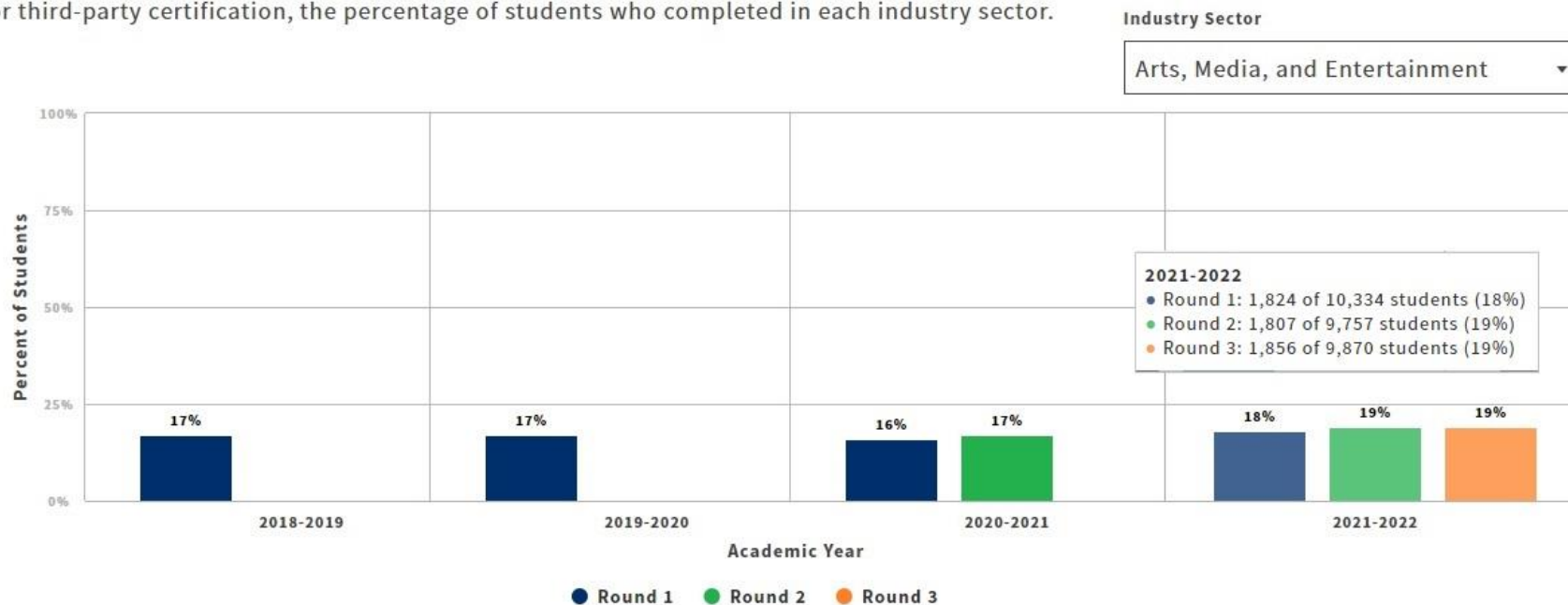

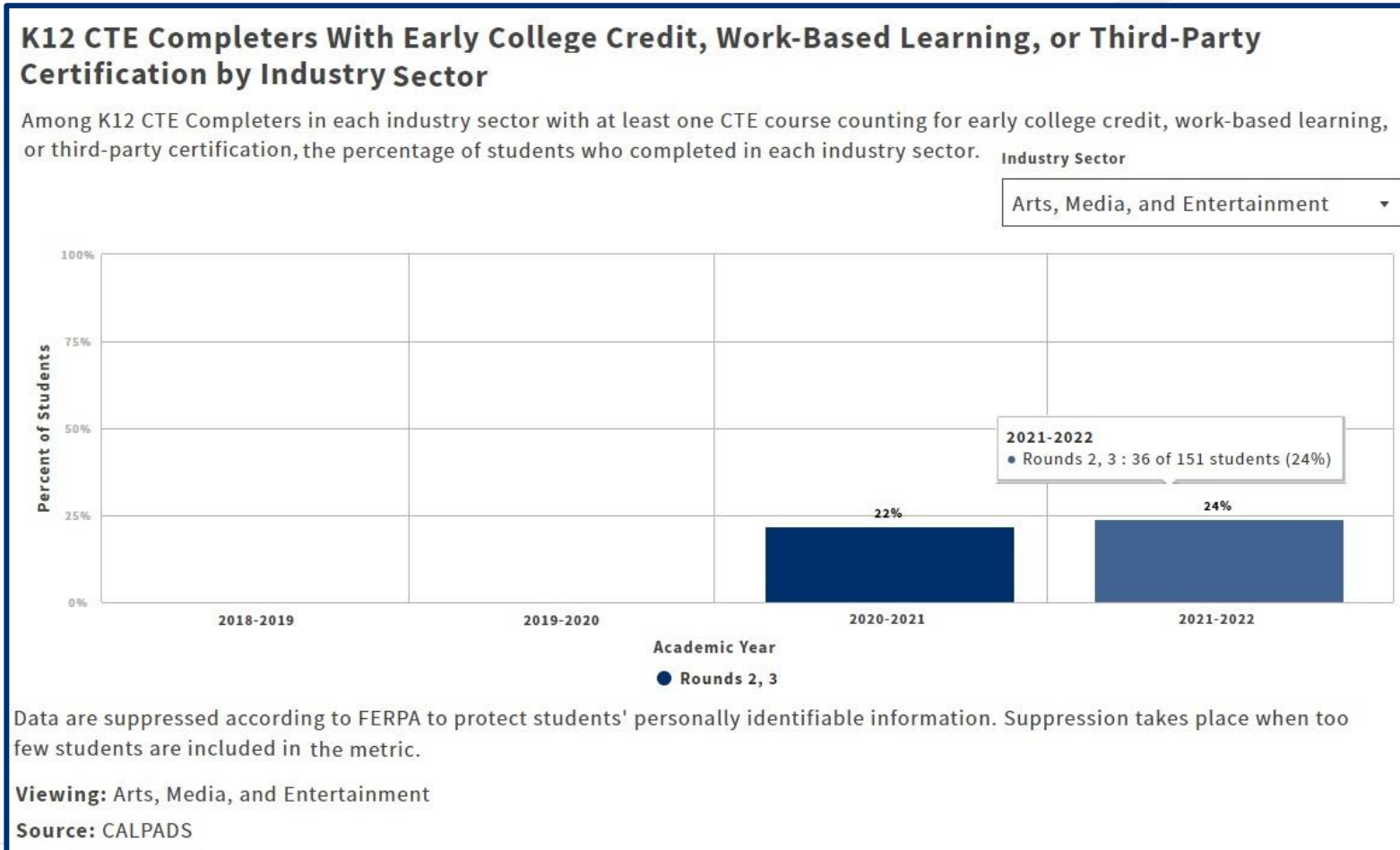

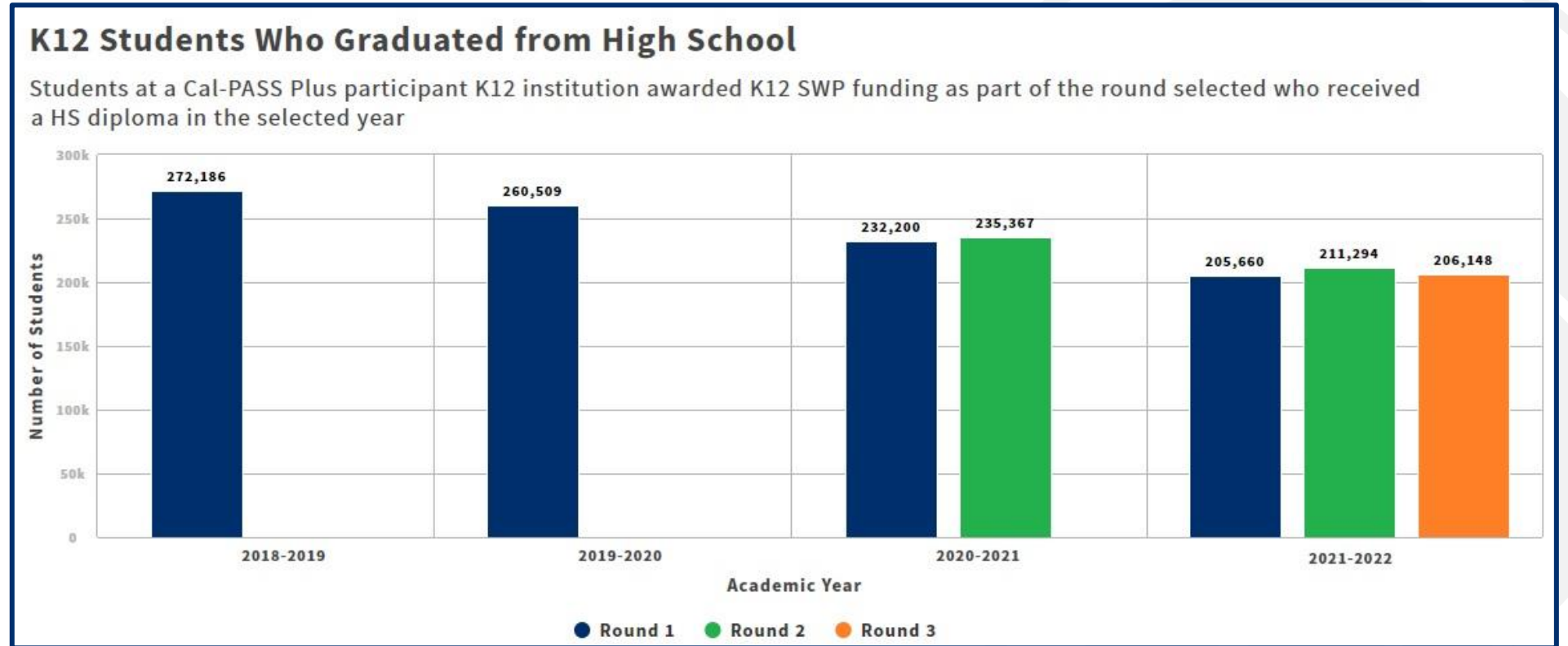

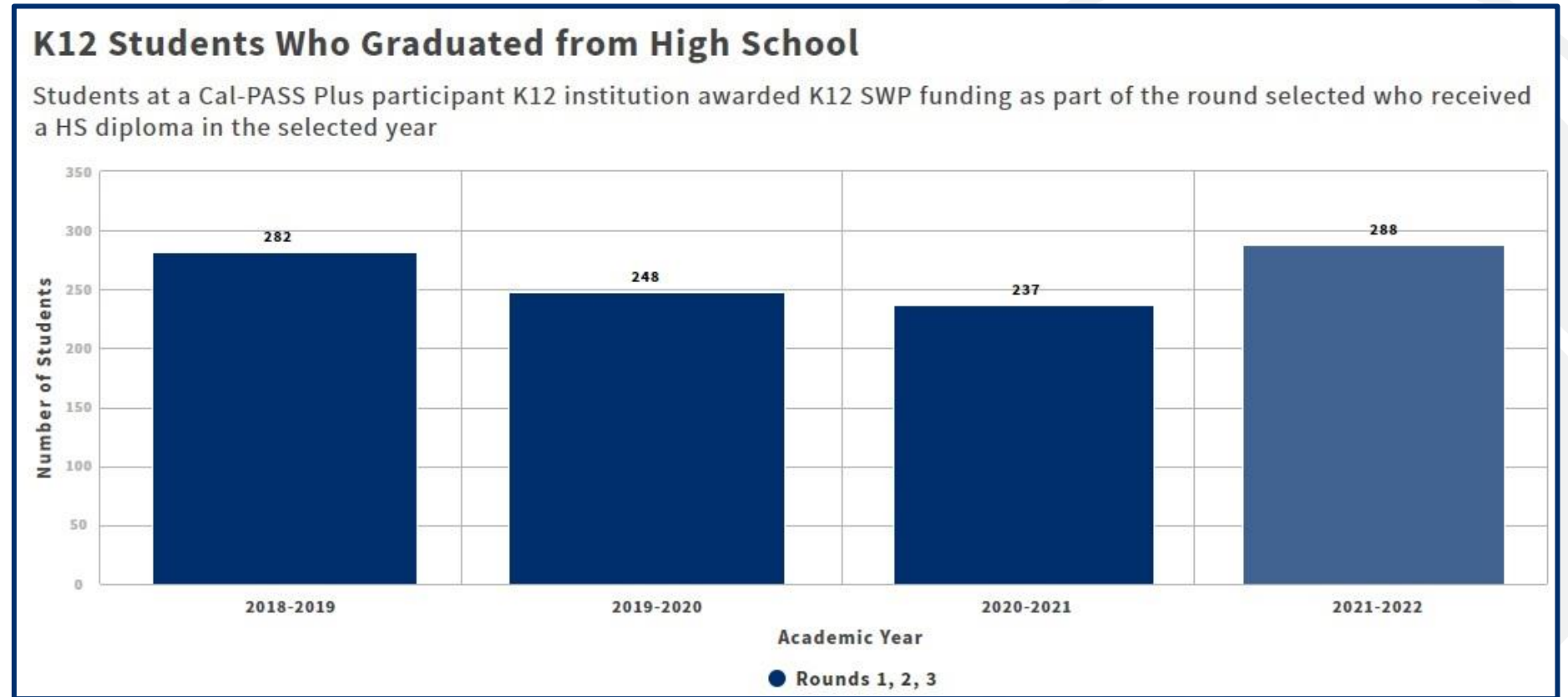

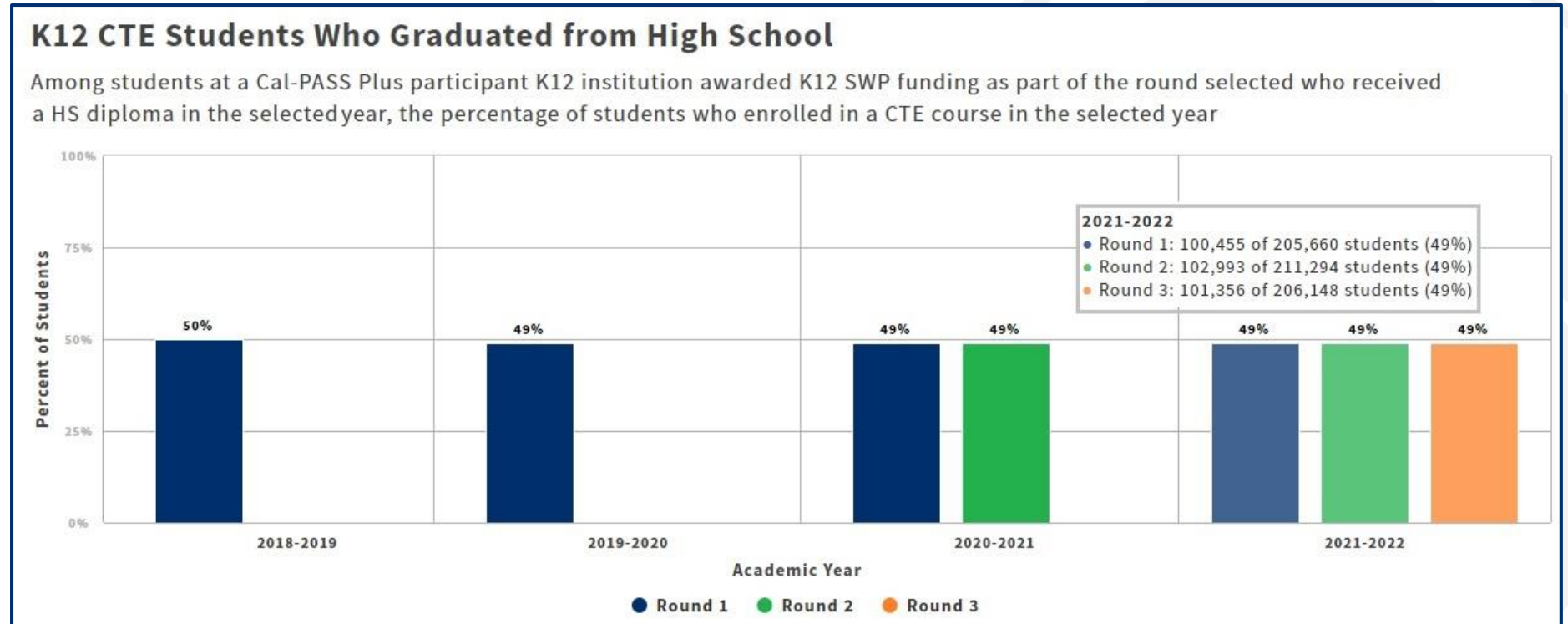

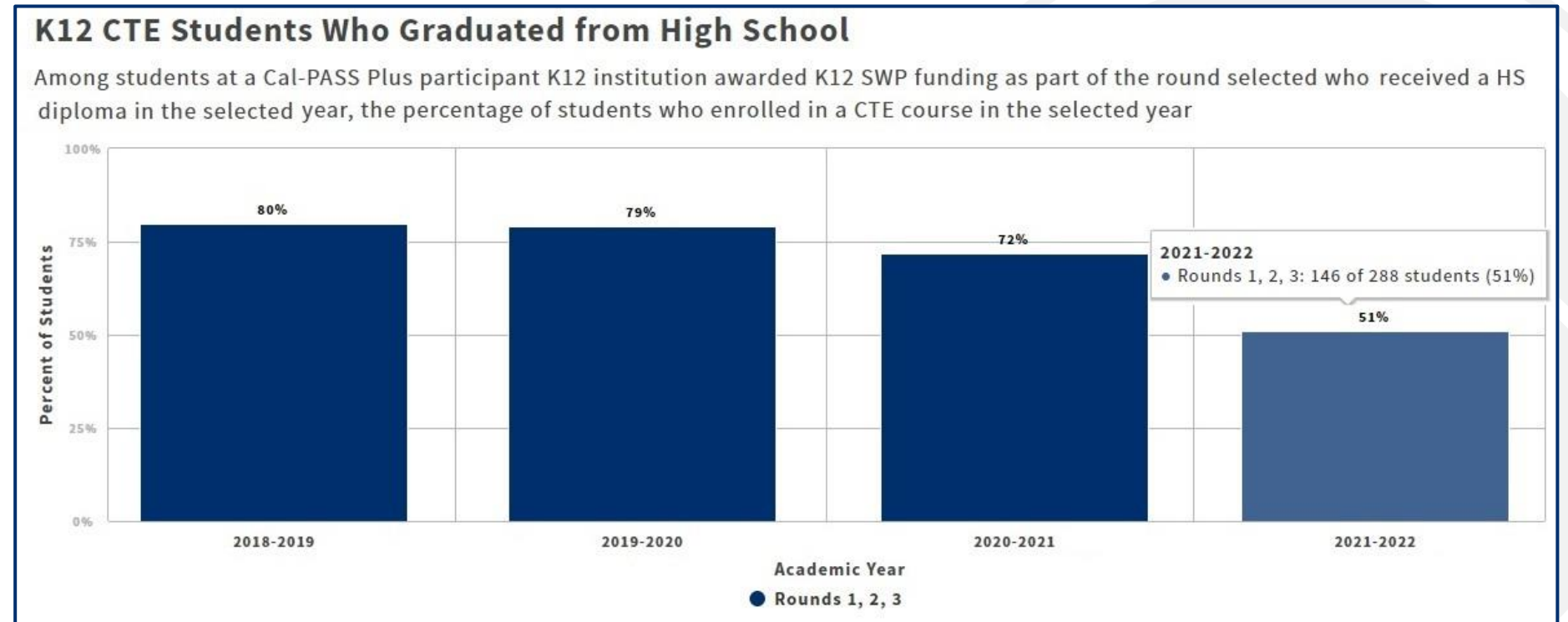

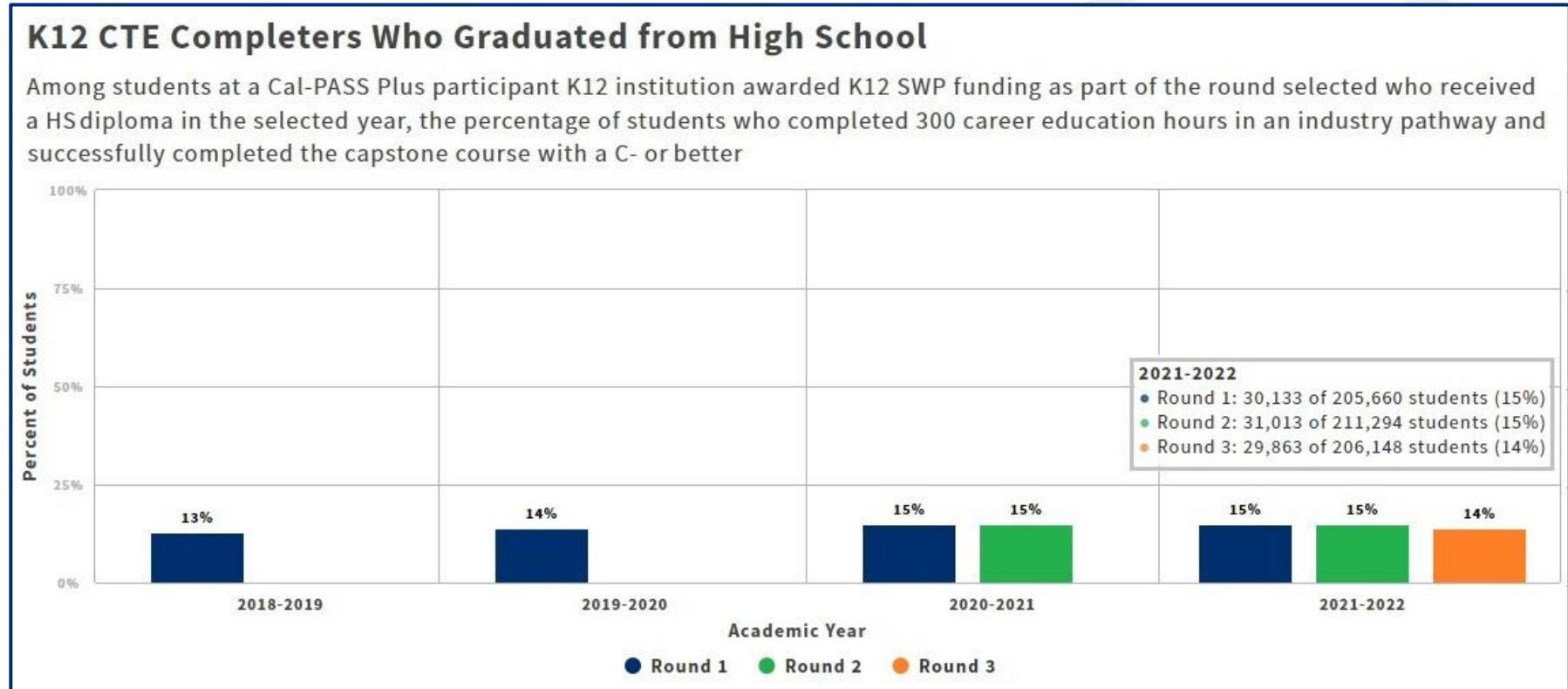

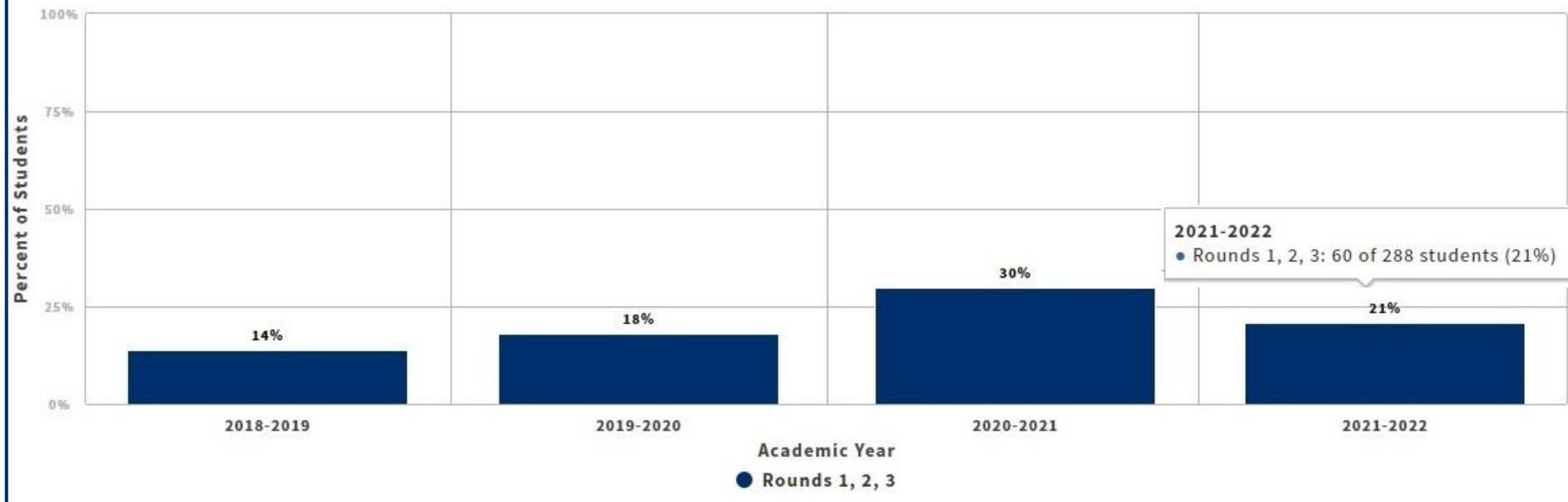

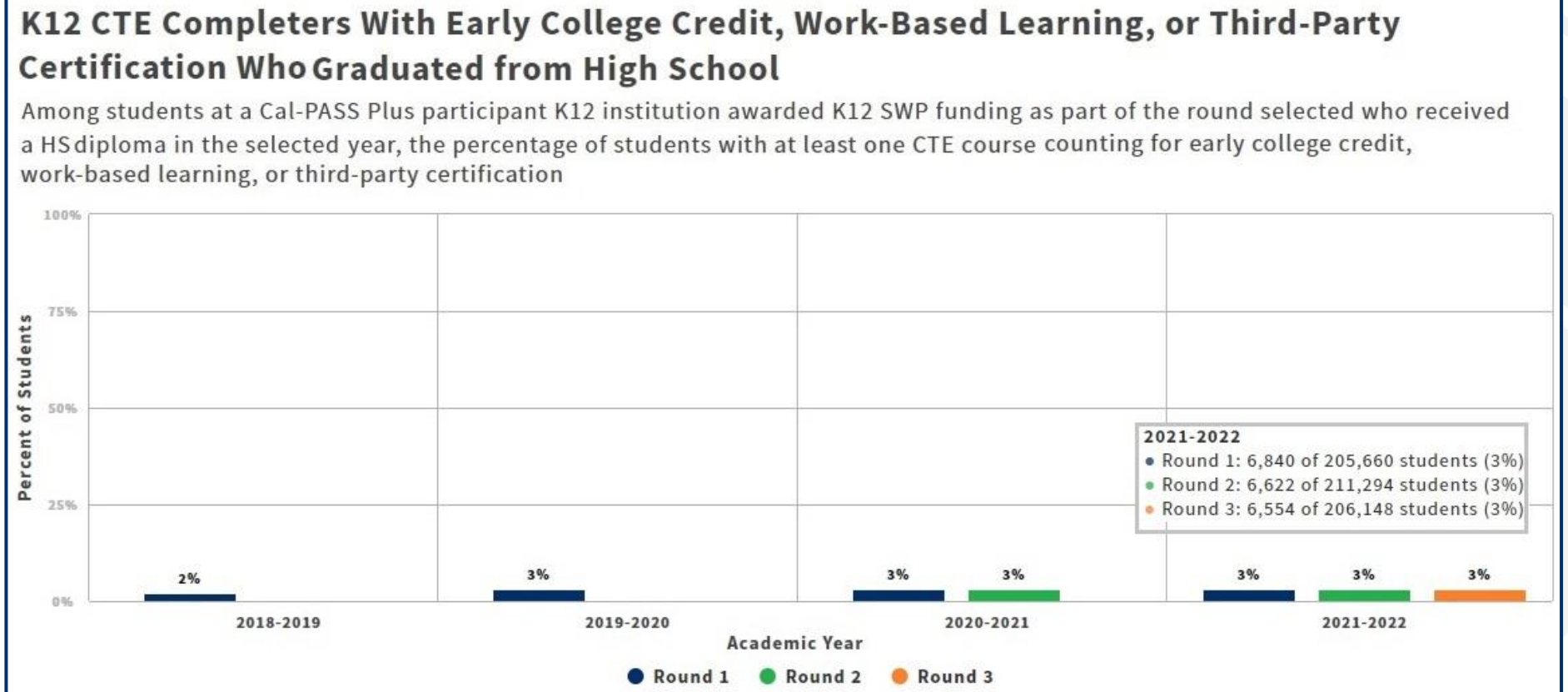

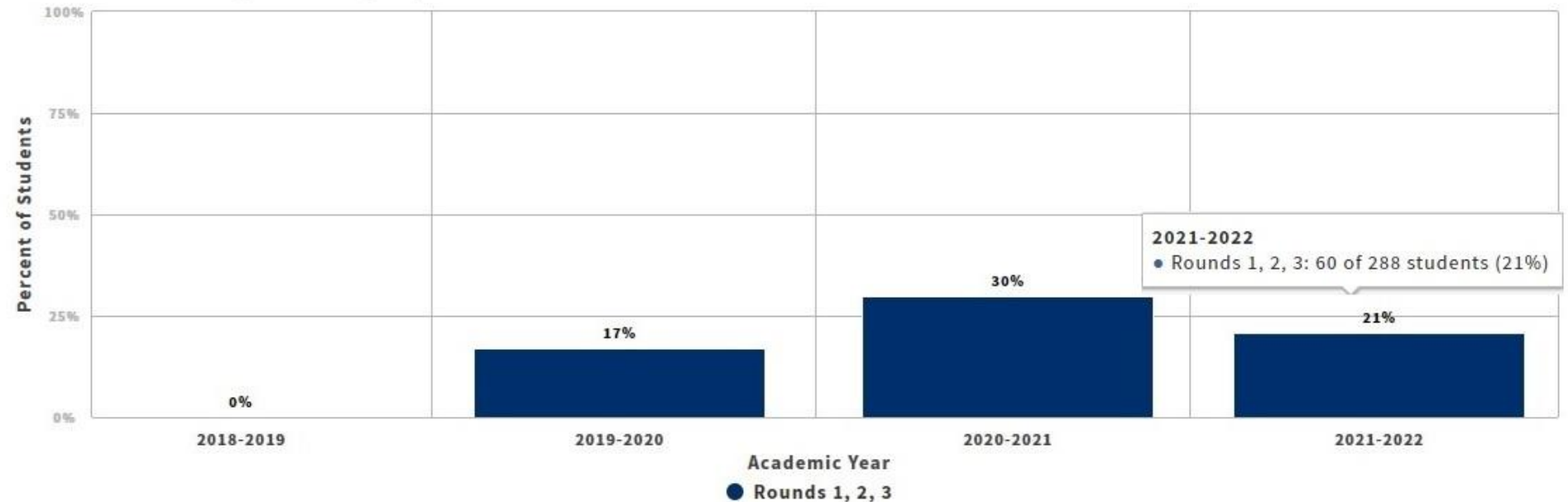

## K12 CTE Completers With Early College Credit, Work-Based Learning, or Third-Party Certification Who Graduated from High School

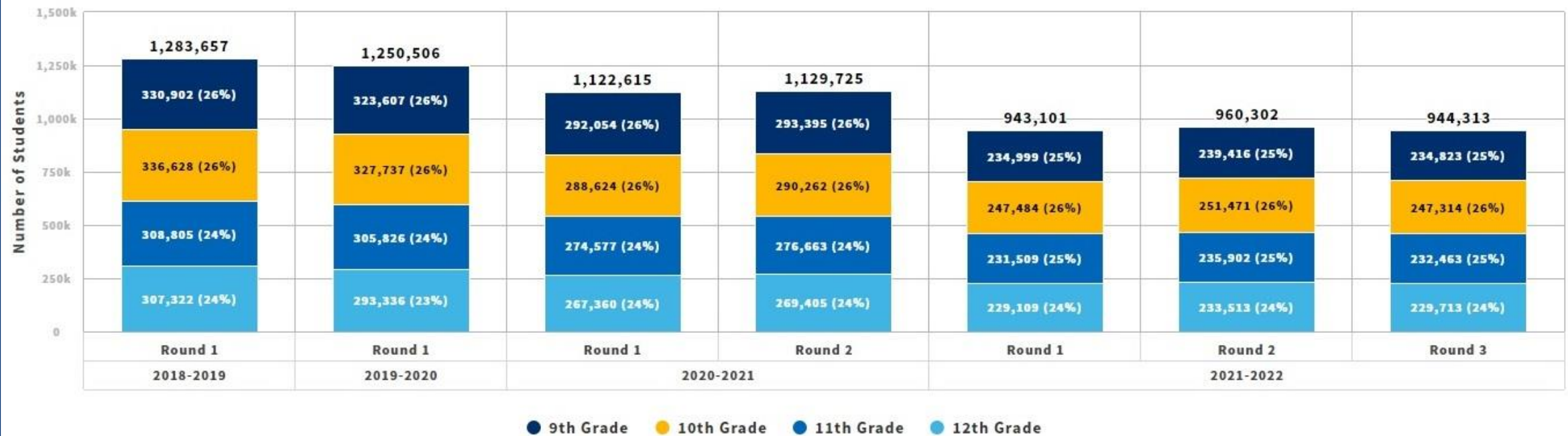

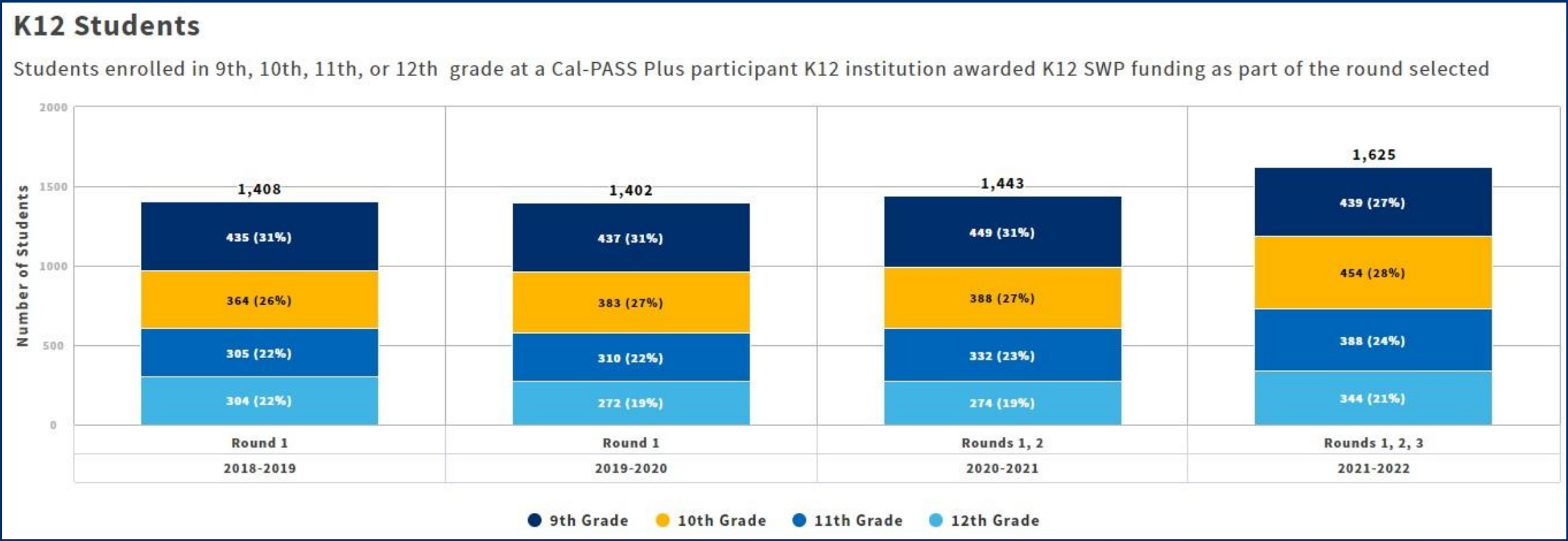

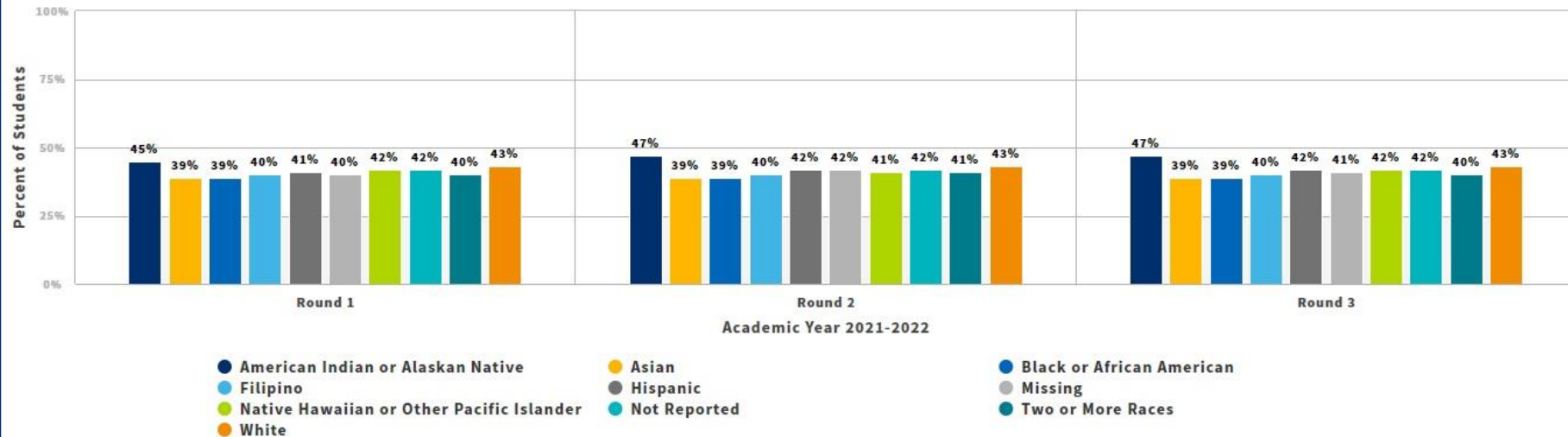

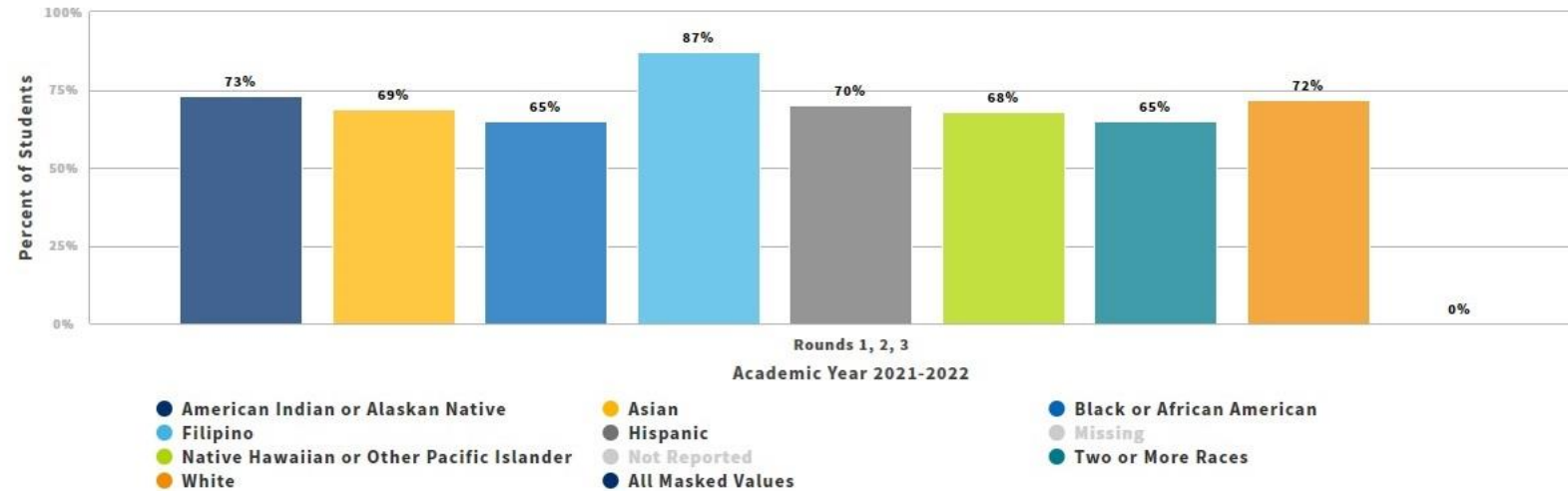

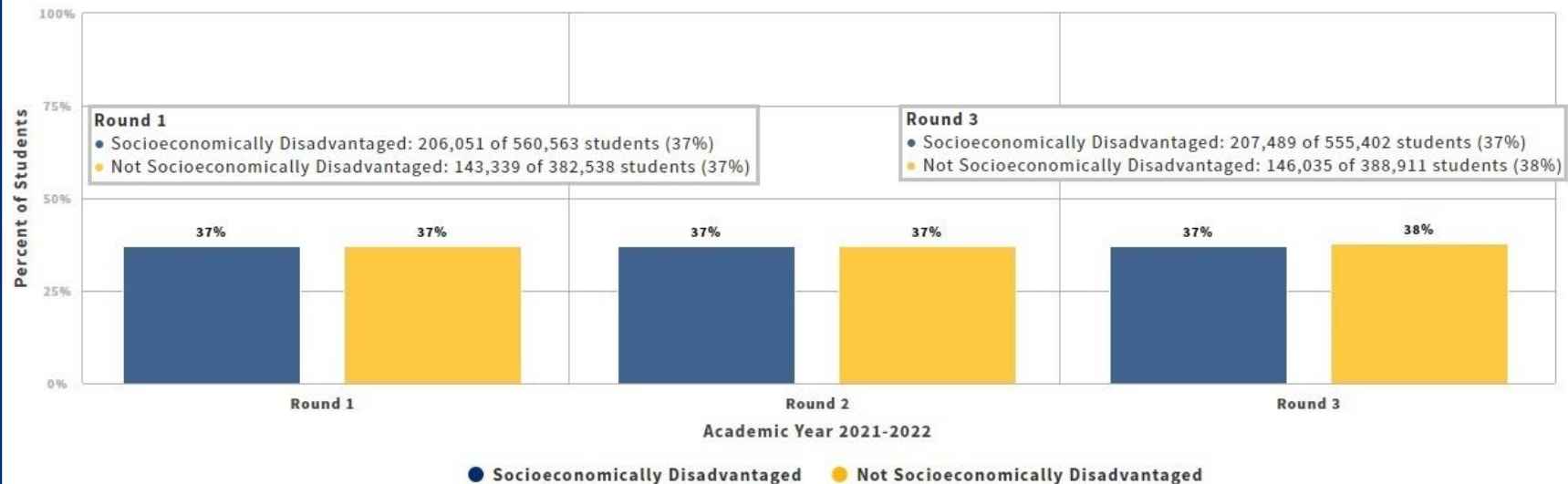

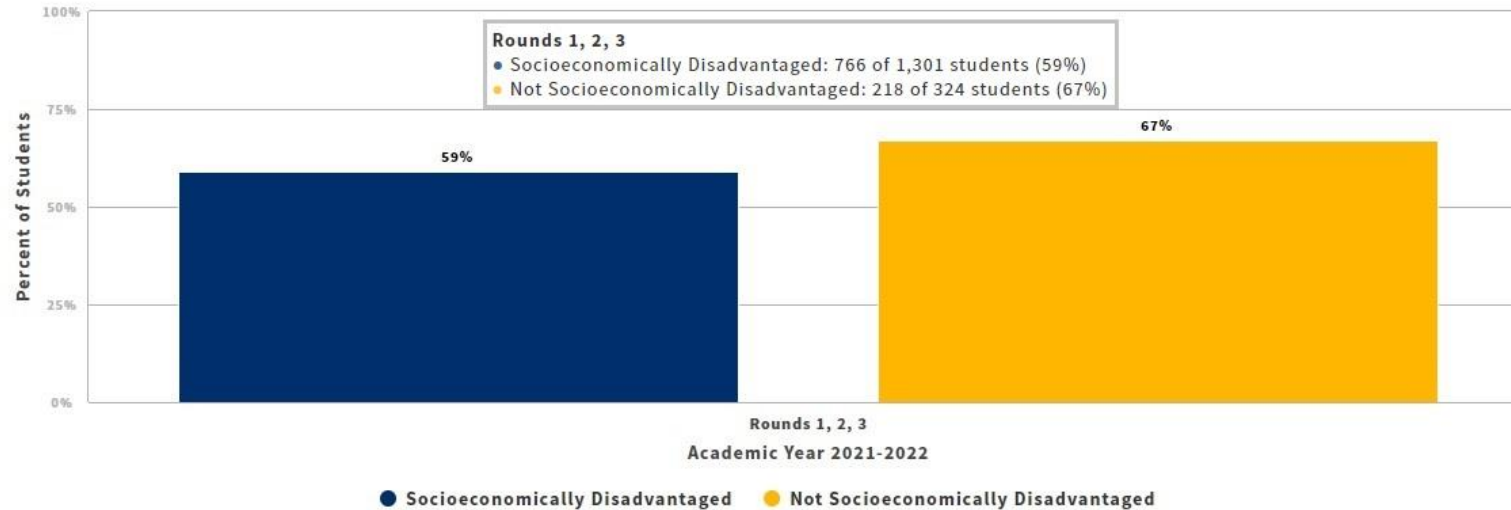

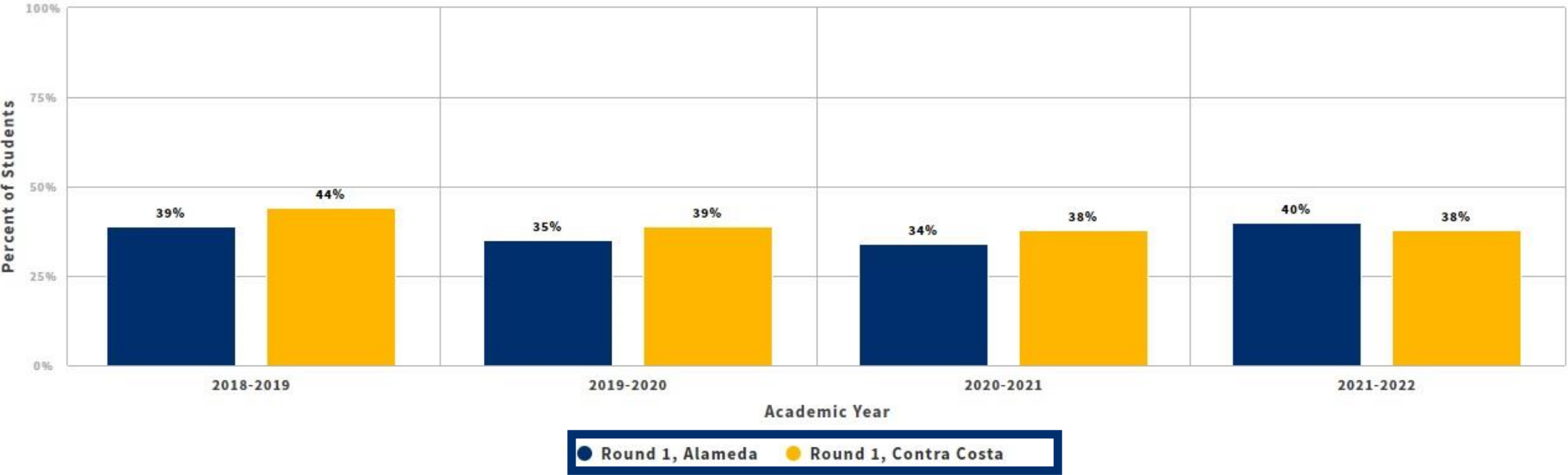

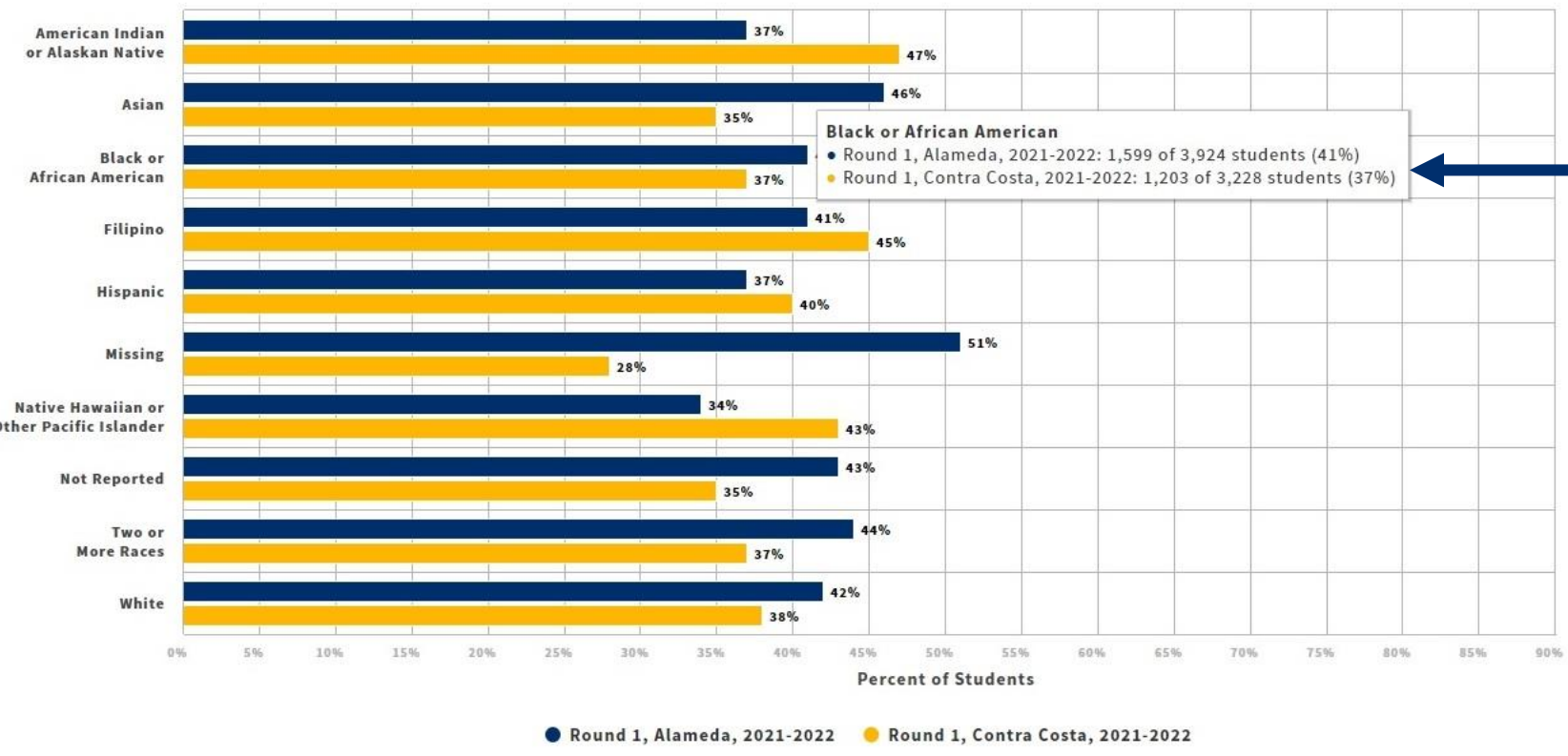
