




The Path Forward: Equitable Guided Pathways



Statewide GP Metrics: Full-Time in First Term

Full Time in First Term (GP)

Among first-time cohort students, the proportion who are enrolled full time in their first primary term




First-time credit cohort students have been enrolling full-time in first term at higher rates over time

Technical Definition

Note: The timeframe allotted for this outcome is in the first primary term in the selected starting academic year and does not change based on the display option selected.

Statewide GP Metrics: Full-Time in First Term



Full-time in first term rates for the 2020-21 cohort are much lower for American Indian and Black students than the 53% overall rate



The Purpose

Identify successes and inform improvements related to students' first year

The Guided Pathways Metrics provide data on students' early momentum

What: Information on first-time students' progression within their first full year

When: Cohorts from 2011-12 to 2020-21

Who: First-time non-special admit credit students who started in any primary term in the selected year, including:

- Those who enrolled in the preceding summer intersession
- Those who previously earned concurrent enrollment credit

Why: Explore the impact of guided pathways efforts on improving student outcomes and reducing continued inequities

Continuous Improvement—Where should we focus efforts?

- Understand students' journey through their first year across key points of momentum
- Measure changes that correspond with Guided Pathway efforts
- Identify progress towards institutional improvement through first year outcomes
- Identify continued inequities

Dashboards in the LaunchBoard

Student Success Metrics—showcases student progression along various educational journeys, from recruitment to completion, transfer and the workforce

Guided Pathways Metrics integrated into the SSM Cohort View—provides a cohort view of first-time students' progress with first-year momentum points for evaluating college redesign efforts.

Community College Pipeline—is the most comprehensive dashboard, offering views of students at the industry sector and program level.

Strong Workforce Program—displays data for CTE students on all CTE programs, industry sectors and individual programs (using the six-digit Taxonomy of Program code).

Adult Education Pipeline—displays data for K-12 adult education and community college noncredit student journeys, including progress, transition, completion and workforce outcomes.

Student Success Metrics: Snapshot & Cohort Views



Snapshot View showcases a snapshot in time of a cross-section of students on the same educational journey:

- All Students
- Adult Ed or ESL
- Short-Term Career Ed.
- Degree/Transfer
- Undecided/Other



Cohort View tracks the same cohort of students over time who started in the same academic year:

- Launched in March 2021
- Includes first-time credit students in the system
- Integration of Guided Pathway metrics

Why Guided Pathways Metrics?


The **Guided Pathways Metrics** offer unique information to understand progress and success of students during their first year taking credit courses

- Explore how a **cohort** of first-time credit students are doing at attaining **KEY progress and momentum** metric outcomes
- Drill down on any metric by **demographics or other characteristics**
- Metrics are **now integrated into the Student Success Metrics Cohort View**

Guided Pathways Metrics in SSM Cohort View

Unique functionality to inform analysis and inquiry:

- Data are from 2011-12 to most current year available
- 11 Disaggregations in SSM in addition to the Demographic disaggregations
- Secondary gender disaggregation also provided
- Displays are by college, district, microregion, macroregion and statewide







The Guided Pathways metrics providing data on students' early momentum and integration into SSM Cohort View



GP Metrics already existed in the SSM Cohort View

*GP Metrics added to SSM Cohort View

**GP Metric existed but not for a first-year timeframe

Guided Pathway student cohort now includes students who start in **Any Primary Term**

First-time non-special admit credit students who started in the **any primary term** of the selected year, including:

- Those who enrolled in the preceding summer term
- Those who previously earned concurrent enrollment credit

Students who earned “**EW**” **grades in all credit courses** in their first term are included in the first-time cohort starting in Spring 2020

Learning Progress

- **Course Success Rate (GP)**
 - Added to SSM Cohort View and aligned with Datamart
 - Note: Denominator excludes “EW” or Excused Withdrawal grades. With onset of COVID in Spring 2020, many students received “EW” grades. Therefore, rates displayed are often higher in 2019-20 and 2020-21 than in prior years as noted on the dashboard.
- **Completed Both Transfer-Level Math and English (GP)**
 - Two views of the metric in a drilldown to toggle between
 - Aligned with Student Centered Funding Formula
 - Expanded View: all students have a full year and credit ESL have 3 years
 - Note: Included in the Metrics Under Development section in the GP dashboard
- **Completed Transfer-Level Math (GP)**
 - Both Views
- **Completed Transfer-Level English(GP)**
 - Both Views

Momentum

- **Persisted from First Primary Term to Next Term (GP)**
 - Same as Retained from Fall to Spring except that now includes students who persisted from Spring to Fall
- **Full-Time in First Term (GP)**
 - Added to SSM Cohort View
- **Full-Time in First Year from First Term (GP)**
 - Added to SSM Cohort View
- **Average Total Units Successfully Completed in First Year (GP)**
 - Added to SSM Cohort View for the One Year Timeframe
 - Replaced the Successfully Completed Unit Thresholds in the Selected Year in Guided Pathways dashboard
 - Different metric included for Average Total Units Successfully Completed Over Three, Four, Six Years



As part of the second 2021-22 release of the dashboard, first-year momentum metrics for evaluating college redesign efforts from the [Guided Pathways dashboard](#) have been brought into to the cohort view. If you have any comments or further feedback, please email launchboard@cccoco.edu. Data are displayed as darker bars when the timeframe allowed to meet the metric outcome is complete. In order to accommodate providing students who start in Spring the same opportunity to complete within a given amount of time, an additional year of data is needed to complete the timeframes. In the 2021-22 release, data are now displayed as lighter bars when the timeframe allowed to meet the metric outcome is not complete. The data for these first-time cohorts in later years with lighter bars will update over time as more years of data are incorporated.

- **Messaging on the SSM Cohort Header**
 - As part of the second 2021-22 release of the dashboard, first-year momentum metrics for evaluating college redesign efforts from the **Guided Pathways dashboard** have been brought into to the cohort view.
- **Messaging included in the Learning Progress and Momentum sections**
 - Metrics in this section now include first year leading indicators for Guided Pathways as indicated by (GP).
- **All Guided Pathway metrics are denoted with (GP) and in teal blue**

Guided Pathways Metrics in SSM Cohort View?

Incomplete Years of Data the Student Success Metrics Cohort View:

- ✓ **The cohort view** allows users to view most outcome metrics either by a **3, 4, or 6-year timeframe**
- ✓ Depending on the starting academic year and cohort length selected, **incomplete data*** may be shown on a chart for a time trend or for a single year disaggregation
- ✓ Complete years of data displayed for a cohort as solid bars are distinguished from **incomplete years** of data displayed as **transparent bars** with additional messaging

* **Incomplete data** means that the timeframe allowed to meet the metric outcome has not completed, e.g., first full year or 3, 4, 6 years



Course Success Rate in First Year (GP)


Among enrollments by students in the cohort, the course success rate in their first year from first term



Note: Information is displayed for first-time students where the timeframe allowed to meet the outcome of the metric is complete as noted by darker bars and incomplete as noted by lighter, partially transparent bars.

Note: More students received “EW” or Excused Withdrawal grades starting in Spring 2020 as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Those grades are excluded from the denominator of success rates to maintain alignment with Datamart. As a result, course success rates are higher in 2020 and 2021 than in prior years. Included and excluded EWs should be carefully examined locally to more completely understand course performance in Spring 2020 and all terms in 2020-21.







Other Student Success Metric Updates

Changes in the most recent
August release

Updates unique to the SSM Cohort View affecting the 2022 Student Equity Plan data

- Denominator for SM 300 Successful Enrollment in the First Year
 - corrected coding issues affecting **ONLY** the denominator or all prospective students who applied for the first-time to attend in the starting cohort year through CCC Apply
 - therefore, the percentages are also affected with NO change to numerators
- **None of the other metrics in the 2022 SEP data are affected**
- Data files were resubmitted through Data on Demand last week (08/01/22)
- New resource and office hours

Other updates to SSM

- **Cohort View: Denominator for SM 701 Job in Field of Study**
 - corrected coding issue for the denominator which included all respondents to the CTE Outcomes Survey instead of all respondents to that question
- **Cohort View: Average No. of Units Successfully Completed in 3, 4, 6 years**
 - 0 units for those by cohort students who did not successfully complete any units in the 3, 4, 6, year timeframe have been added into the average calculations for this metric
- **Snapshot View: Denominator for Persisted Fall to Spring**
 - corrected coding issue for the denominator to identify students using exclusively the derived key per LaunchBoard protocols
- **Snapshot View: Short-Term Career Education Journey, Earned 9+ CTE Units, and Noncredit Workforce Milestone**
 - one TOP code, 126000 Health Professions, Transfer Core Curriculum, was incorrectly flagged as CTE and has been updated


