



Strong Workforce Program (SWP) and 17% SWP Incentive Allocation: Who is Included as a SWP or CTE Student?

1. Enrollment in the system as a non-special admit student on a TOP06 code assigned to a vocational sector in at least one term in the selected year

Student who met all of the following criteria:

Has an enrollment in the system •

Has a value in the Student Enrollment Data Elements (SX) file


- AND in a program area that is assigned to a vocational sector AND CB03 is assigned to a vocational sector
- AND is enrolled as a non-Special Admit student in at least one • term of the selected year

WHERE [SB15 IS (1,2,3,5,X) in at least one term of the selected year



What is a TOP code or program area assigned to a vocational sector?

Strong Workforce Program (SWP) and 17% SWP Incentive Allocation: Who is Included as a SWP or CTE Student (continued)?

- 2. AND had a **minimum credit enrollment** at the selected college in the selected year Tutoring or Supervised Skills (with pre- and post-COVID definitions)
- AND attempted at least 0.5 credit units in a single course on any TOP code at the selected college AND [CB04 IN (C, D) AND SXD3>0.5]
- OR EITHER has 12 positive attendance hours in the selected year in noncredit courses not in Tutoring or Supervised Study Skills

OR [CB04 = N]

AND CB03 NOT IN (493009, 493014) AND SUM (SX05) \geq 12 across all colleges AND SX05 < 2000 WHERE GI03 is within the selected year]

OR enrolled in noncredit courses not in Tutoring or Supervised Study Skills in Spring term 2020 or in any term in academic year 2020-21 or 2021-22

OR [CB04 = N]AND CB03 NOT IN (493009, 493014) AND Has a value in the Student Enrollment Data Elements (SX) file WHERE GI03 is in (203, 204, 205, 206, 207, 208, 211, 212, 213, 214, 215, 216, 217, 218, 221, 222, 223, 224)]]



OR had a minimum noncredit enrollment at the selected college in the selected year on any TOP code EXCEPT on

Minimum Credit: on ANY TOP code – not restricted to vocational

Minimum Noncredit: Pre-COVID definition where SX05>=12 on ANY TOP code EXCEPT 493009 or 493014

Minimum Noncredit: **Post-COVID** definition

where only noncredit enrollment on ANY **TOP code EXCEPT** 493009 or 493014









Strong Workforce Program (SWP) and 17% SWP Incentive Allocation: Who is Included as a SWP or CTE Student (continued)?

credit enrollment requirement met OR noncredit enrollment in the selected year

AND count students at any college and on any TOP code assigned to a vocational sector where a student • took 0.5 or more units or noncredit courses the selected year

Summary of SWP Students Definition:

- Enrollment required on a TOP code assigned to a vocational **sector** to be included at the college in the selected year as a non-special admit student for SWP
- BUT minimum credit and noncredit enrollment requirements are NOT required on a TOP code assigned to a vocational sector in order to align SWP and CCP dashboards
- AND SWP students are **counted at any college and on any** TOP code assigned to a vocational sector where minimum credit enrollment requirement met or has a noncredit enrollment



3. AND count students at any college and on any TOP code assigned to a vocational sector where minimum





Community College Pipeline (CCP): For CCP, enrollment required on ANY TOP code to be included at the college in the selected year but can filter on CTE programs

Same in CCP

For CCP, students are **counted at any** college and on ANY TOP code where minimum credit enrollment requirement is met or has a noncredit enrollment



Two Caveats Related to TOP codes for determining SWP or CTE **Students**

- - TOP codes are only assigned to a vocational sector at the TOP06 level
- be populated with data for metrics displayed on LaunchBoard for SWP or CCP
 - FERPA suppressed data would be displayed
 - additional TOP codes

Every TOP code flagged with "*" in the <u>Taxonomy of Programs Manual</u> are included as a "TOP code assigned to a vocational sector" with ONE additional TOP code included as a vocational TOP code but NOT flagged with an "*" • 083600 Recreation, which is NOT flagged as "*", is assigned to the Education and Human Development sector in SWP

CTE Outcome Survey: who is included as credit and noncredit CTE students?

WHO WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE SURVEY?

taking courses at the college approximately 1.5 to 2 years prior to the current survey year. The cohort includes:

- 1. Completers: Have received a vocational/CE award that is Chancellor's Office approved and enroll in 0-5 units each semester the next year (not enrolled or only minimally enrolled).
- 2. Terminal Certificates: Received a vocational/CE award of at least 6 units that is not Chancellor's Office approved (such as certificates with less than 12 units) and are not enrolled the following year.
- 3. Skills Builders: Have completed 9 units that are SAM coded A-D. with at least one course SAM coded A-C (within the prior 3 years), have not received a vocational/CE award of 6 or more units, and are not enrolled the following year.




1. Same student universe for SCFF and All Students journey in SSM

- For SCFF and Student Success Metrics (SSM) Snapshot View: record or enrollment in the SX file as a non-special admit student in the year
 - NOTE: In the SSM snapshot view, the metric Earned 9+ CTE Units is available for the following student journeys: Short-Term Career Education, Undecided/Other and All Students journeys (as noted in the denominator)

2. BUT different method for identifying students: SCFF vs LaunchBoard

- Derived intersegmental key (last, first, DOB, gender) vs MIS student identifier (SB00)
 - Proper de-duplication
 - Consistency across dashboards in LaunchBoard
 - Allows for tracking students across regions
 - Note: If student ID is not SSN, then same student may have a different student ID at different colleges and different districts
 - Recognize chance for identifier clashes (happens in very low rates 0.5%)
