Putting Data to Work

What is it?

The CTE Outcomes Survey (CTEOS) tracks California community college CTE students into the workforce

Step 1

The CTEOS team at Santa Rosa Junior College (SRJC) asks the Chief Instructional Officer at each college to identify their college's primary contact

Step 2

The Chancellor's Office MIS unit generates a statewide list of students who are eligible to participate in the CTEOS

Step 3

That list is sent to the CTEOS team at SRJC where it is divided into smaller college-level lists and then sent to each college's primary contact

Step 4

The primary contact ensures that student contact information (name, email address, phone number) is appended to the list and sent to SRJC

Step 5

SRJC distributes the CTEOS to those students, first by email, then by SMS text, then by telephone

Step 6

When data collection finishes, SRJC sends reports to primary contacts, and results are displayed on the LaunchBoard
